


# WATERING TIMER INSTRUCTION MANUAL

### <u>CAUTION:</u> PROTECT THE DEVICE AND ITS PARTS FROM FREEZING Working temperature: 5~60°.

Remove the device from the faucet and store it indoors until the temperature is suitable for the device.

- 1. Charge input/interface: 5V / Micro usb
- 2. Keep Pressing Set button for 5 seconds to turn on or turn off the device.
- 3. LCD display:



### 4. How to set up the automatical program:

**SET** button is for setting individual settings of the control panel. After pressing **SET** button, relative function will flash and it is waiting to be set. Press **SET** button again to move to the next option and set the next value.

- + button is for adding number
- button is for deducting number

After setting Starting Hour, Interval Time and Watering Time, please wait 10 seconds. When you see  $\bigcirc$ , the program settings are ready.

### Program example:

## A. Water every morning at 8:00 and every evening at 20:00 for 5 minutes each watering.

Set the *Start Hour* at 8:00, set *Interval Time* to 12 (hours) and *Watering Time* to 5 (minutes). Wait 10 seconds, the timer will begin its first program and run for 5 minutes at 8:00. The timer will now water everyday at 8:00 and 20:00 for 5 minutes until you change it.

### B. Water every morning at 8:00 for 10 minutes.

You set the *Start Hour* at 8:00, set *Interval Time* to 24 (hours) and *Watering Time* to 10 (minutes). Wait 10 seconds, the timer will begin its first program and run for 10 minutes when 8:00. The timer will now water everyday at 8:00 for 10 minutes until you change it.

5. How to water manually:

Press *Man* button to water manually. Press it to start watering, press again to stop watering.

6. How to set up children lock

To lock the panel, press + button and - buttons at same time. All buttons are locked. Press + and - buttons at same time again to unlock all buttons.

### TIMER INSTALLATION:

- · Hold the unit steady.
- · Loosen the LARGE LOCKING COLLAR RING located in the top of the timer until the inner BLACK FAUCET COLLAR is loose.
- · Screw the **BLACK FAUCET COLLAR** onto the faucet/tap until it is hand tight, and then hand tighten the **LARGE LOCKING COLLAR RING**.
- · Turn on the faucet/tap to open the flow of water.

### (DO NOT USE WRENCHES OR PLIERS TO TIGHTEN THE COLLARS.)

#### **TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDE:**

If the water does not come on, please check the following:

- 1. Be sure the faucet/tap is turned on.
- 2. Check to be sure the batteries are in good condition. If battery power is low, please charge it.
